Dear Resident

I am writing to update you following the recent letter you should have received regarding the feedback from our consultation on the redevelopment plans for London Irish. We have now analysed all of the 340 responses completed at the public exhibition or returned via freepost or email.

As a direct result of the comments recorded in the questionnaires and from listening to the concerns of the local community during discussions that our project team members had with members of the public during the exhibition, we have undertaken a major scheme review.

Several key issues were raised during the consultation process particularly in relation to the proposals for The Avenue and we have sought to respond directly these concerns when reworking the masterplan with Urban Initiatives. A number of changes have been included such as incorporation of a new health centre, a significant decrease in the number of units proposed as well as the incorporation of some larger, detached properties all as a direct response to the feedback received.

Now we have completed the scheme review, we would like invite you to come and see the final plans for yourselves at London Irish, The Avenue, Sunbury-on-Thames, TW16 5EQ on Saturday 14 November 2009 from 10am - 4pm.

As we have previously mentioned, the revision process has impacted on our timetable and we now are looking to submit planning applications for The Avenue and Hazelwood sites at the beginning of December.

We will continue to keep you updated at every stage.
