

**SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL
PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES
IN FRENCH STREET (C236) SUNBURY ON THAMES**

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Section 90(A) to (I) inclusive of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce a series of physical measures to improve safety and reduce vehicle speeds in French Street (C236) Sunbury On Thames. The type of physical measures and their locations are as described below:-

- (1) Two abreast speed cushions** centred 30m south-west of the centre of the junction with Staines Road East, which will be 75mm in height, 3m long and 1.7m wide;
- (2) Three abreast speed cushions** centred 95m south of the speed cushions in (1) above, which will be 75mm in height, 3m long and 1.7m wide
- (3) Three abreast speed cushions** centred 215m south of the speed cushions in (2) above, which will be 75mm in height, 3m long and 1.7m wide;
- (4) Three abreast speed cushions** centred 81m south of the speed cushions in (3) above, which will be 75mm in height, 2.5m long and 1.6m wide.

A copy of the plan showing the location of each of the measures described above may be examined free of charge at (i) Surrey Highways, Hazel House, Merrow Lane, Guildford, Surrey GU4 7BQ, between 9.30am and 4.30pm; and (ii) Sunbury Library, The Parade, Staines Road West, Sunbury On Thames, Middlesex, TW16 7AB, during normal opening hours.

If you wish to object to, or make any other representation regarding any or all of the proposed measures referred to above, you must send the grounds for your objection, or representations, in writing, to the undersigned by 22 November 2019.
